Chosen 300 is known throughout the region for providing meals and services to the homeless, however it also provides bulk food and quality of life assistance to seniors in the community. Seniors have not only been impacted greatly by the COVID 19 Pandemic economically as well as suffering from food insufficiency; but they have also have been dealing with loneliness, depression, and inability to socialize with others.

On Sunday, September 26th at 7:00 PM Chosen 300 is partnering with the Walnut Street Theatre to provide A NIGHT OUT FOR SENIORS to see BEEHIVE - the 60's Musical at Walnut Street Theatre.

This is the final dress rehearsal before the Theatre officially re-opens for public performances on September 28th after a long closure from the pandemic. Chosen 300 Executive Director Brian Jenkins states, "I applaud the Walnut Street Theatre for kicking off its re-opening by first helping vulnerable seniors in our community, and I encourage the public to come back and support the arts."

Seniors will gather at 4:00 PM at the Bethlehem Baptist Church of Spring House PA for Lunch, then board busses to travel to the Walnut Street Theatre and arrive between 6:15 and 6:30PM with the play beginning at 7:00 PM
